It is missing many of the nutrients found in ground rice and ground brown rice.</p>	<p>1st Ingredient: Chicken</p> <p>The clean combination of flesh and skin with or without accompanying bone, derived from the parts or whole carcasses of chicken</p> <p>Foods that list “real chicken” or chicken first include the water weight in this ingredient. Chicken in this form consists of 70% water.</p>
<p>2nd Ingredient: (Whole) Ground Yellow Corn</p> <p>An ideal ingredient when used correctly in a formula. It is 99% digestible, an excellent energy source, and one of the best natural Omega 6 fatty acid sources.</p> <p>Omega6 fatty acid (also known as Linoleic Acid) is a required nutritional component of the canine and feline diet. It cannot be synthesized within a dog or cat’s body so it must be consumed in some form of food so that other fatty acids can then be synthesized internally. Linoleic Acid maintains skin and coat condition in dogs and cats. Without enough linoleic acid cats may experience dull dry coat, hair loss, greasy skin and increased susceptibility to skin inflammation.</p> <p>Our corn is completely pesticide free.</p>	<p>2nd Ingredient: Corn Gluten Meal</p> <p>The by-product after the manufacture of corn syrup or starch, and is the dried residue after the removal of the bran, germ, and starch.</p> <p>Corn Gluten Meal is a low ash source of protein and acts as a urine acidifier. In small amounts, it offers preventive health benefits.</p>	<p>2nd Ingredient: Chicken By-Product Meal</p> <p>By-product meal consists of the dry, ground, rendered, clean parts of the carcass of slaughtered chicken such as necks, feet, undeveloped eggs, and intestines.</p>
<p>3rd Ingredient: Brewers Rice</p> <p>Our Brewers Rice has never seen the inside of a brewery. It is simply broken pieces of human grade rice used in the manufacture of food and beverages.</p> <p>Our rice is herbicide free.</p>	<p>3rd Ingredient: Animal Fat</p> <p>Animal fat is a byproduct of meat meal processing. The origin of the contributing animals is never known, and the resulting oil is very low in linoleic acid.</p>	<p>3rd Ingredient: Corn Grits</p> <p>Coarsely ground grains from which the bran and germ have been removed. Corn Grits are a grain fragment, missing the majority of their nutrients.</p> <p>Fragments are lower-cost by-products of another food manufacturing process (e.g. Brewer’s rice—a waste product of the alcohol industry).</p>

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<p>4th Ingredient: Pork Meal</p> <p>The digestibility of Pork Meal is second only to Fish Meal and far more digestible than beef. Pork Meal unlike bacon is very low in nitrates.</p> <p>Our Pork Meal is hormone and antibiotic free, comes from facilities preparing meat for your dinner table, and is shipped fresh.</p> <p>Pork Meal is an expensive ingredient so you seldom see it in other pet food brands. It is very palatable and is a hypoallergenic ingredient. It has an excellent amino acid and Omega fatty acid profile.</p>	<p>4th Ingredient: Chicken Meal</p> <p>Meals are 11 times more protein-concentrated than meat.
